

Terms and Conditions

9 February 2016

The following terms and conditions apply for tickets purchased for the think.BDPST conference:

- Tickets are non-transferable as each customer receives a personalised voucher upon purchasing his or her ticket. In addition, no exchange of tickets will be made under any circumstances.
- No refund on tickets will be made under any circumstances except in case of event cancellation and *vis maior* (including but not limited to war, revolution, natural disaster, or not foreseeable political events).
- Customers are asked to show their vouchers in order to receive their badges. Badges can be collected on the spot from 4:30pm onward on 8 March, and 8am onward on 9-10 March.
- A third party will not be allowed to collect the ticket of a customer unless authorised in writing to do so.
- The resale of tickets is forbidden. The Antall József Knowledge Centre has the right to cancel tickets that have been resold.
- The Antall József Knowledge Centre may refuse admission to any persons whose conduct is disorderly or unbecoming.
- think.BDPST is the trademark of the Antall József Knowledge Centre. Therefore, no audio or video recording is allowed during the conference unless having the written consent of the statutory representative of the Knowledge Centre. Moreover, although the event is open to the press, performers and speakers might have an objection against being photographed. Guests, therefore, are kindly asked to refrain from taking pictures.
- The Antall József Knowledge Centre reserves the right to change the programme.
- The conference will receive high publicity and will be recorded in its entirety. With attending the conference, the customer agrees to have his or her image reused in promotional photographs or his or her likeness appear in any live or recorded video display.
- The Knowledge Centre may cancel, interrupt, or stop the event in case foul weather, dangerous situations or any other circumstances beyond its control occur.
- Customers may expect an airport-style check-in at the conference venues and might be subjected to hand over prohibited items including but not limited to weapons or dangerous substances.
